Ben's early years were spent in the Oconalufty area.




Early Life


Edward Clarence Conner 1863-1937

- Schooled

- Worked very hard
- Had a very eccentric uncle
- Moved to Qualla area in adolescence

- A very dangerous profession
- Living in a boarding house



No service during World War I


1910

September 8, 1916

- Ben was working as an engineer
- Died in a tragic coal train derailment on a Friday night.
- His body was not found until the next day.





Burial in the Bryson City Cemetery

- 'Ace' Enloe and some of his sons arrived on the 9th to accompany Ben's body home.
- Not buried at Oconalufty or Judson
- Bryson City Cemetery Committee (chaired by DK Collins) provided plot
- Funeral services and burial on September 10th
- Plot purchased on September 16th

Estate

- Probated in Asheville on September 12th
- Worth \$400 (\$8951 in 2016)
- Executor was Ben's brother,
 Clyde Bascombe Enloe







A Sad Epilogue



- Frederick Clarence died 25 April 1917 (buried B.C. Cemetery)
- Clarinda died 10
 December 1917 at
 Judson (buried B.C.
 Cemetery)
- Outlived at least 4 of her children.
