

Dr. David Edmond Trawick, 82, died Tuesday, December 7, 2021 at Asbury Health & Rehabilitation in Charlotte. A native of Bryson City, NC, he was born to the late James and Lexie Gibson Trawick. He graduated from Swain High School in 1957 and went on to attend Mars Hill College and then the University of North Carolina Chapel Hill where he obtained a DDS degree.
