She attended Page High School where she served as student body president, a member of the National Honor Society and class Valedictorian. She made her debut in Greensboro and was crowned "Miss Greensboro." Kathy attended Duke University graduating in 1968 with a degree in Psychology. She loved her alma mater and remained a devoted fan Duke athletics, even traveling to the State of Washington in 1986 to watch the Soccer team win Duke's first NCAA National Championship. After college, she began her career with NCR Corporation as a programmer and computer systems engineer and then worked at DataFlow Corporation for twenty plus years serving as Vice President of the Company.

After graduating from Duke, Kathy lived in Durham where she became an active member of the Junior League, the Canterbury Club, and taught Sunday school at Epworth United Methodist Church for 11 years. As a master's bridge player, she loved competition and would soundly beat anyone watching Jeopardy with her on a given night. She will be remembered as intelligent, practical, compassionate, friendly, dependable, outgoing and generous to everyone. Her greatest joy was making others happy.
